First and foremost, let me thank every one of you who made the April Verband meeting from April 28-30 the success it was. It would have been impossible without you!! We had about 144 people from 14 cities and Canada in attendance. We received numerous compliments, not only for the food we served (THANK YOU LADIES), but also for our facility.

At the presidents meeting decisions were made as to where and when the various Verband events would be held throughout the years. There are two that affect us:

- 1. We will host the Landestreffen over Labor Day in 2027.
- 2. We will also host the April Verband meeting in 2029 and our Jugend will travel to Europe in 2029 as well.

We held the Stiftung meeting (our financial foundation) on Sunday, April 30th, and set the budget for the coming year. Two big changes for this year are:

- 1. The stipend for the Europa Reise was increased from \$3,000 to \$6,000 due to cost increases.
- 2. Since there will be no Jugendlager this year, the decision was made to give \$4,000 to Hansi Muller who, along with several others, is coming to the US in November of this year to give several workshops in Chicago and Cleveland. Clubs will send group leaders and some youth to one or the other of these workshops.

Katy Abt announced the topic for this year's Oma Abt Award --"What effect has the Donauschwaben culture had on me". The winners of the contest will be announced at our Labor Day gathering.

We have moved Donauschwabentag from August 13th to Sunday, August 20th due to the fact that we will have a visiting dance group from Pecs, Hungary here on that day. We're the first city on their tour and I encourage you to come out and experience them. The last time they were here was 2018. See page 5 of this newsletter for details.


